

- **Furniture:** Finding safe furniture can be tough! Consider natural options, like wicker and wood, that don't contain flame retardants. Some finishes and manufactured wood alternatives off-gas VOCs, so stay away from particleboard, fiberboard, and certain types of plywood, which also contain high levels of formaldehyde, a known carcinogen.
- **Scenting:** Research has shown some scented candles produce smoke laced with almost as many toxins as those produced by cigarettes! To avoid dangerous fumes and soot, use soy or beeswax candles with pure essential oils and non-cored fabric wicks (and keep them trimmed short).

Hemp Seeds

Hemp seeds are one of the most nutritionally complete foods in the world: a complete protein, high in fiber, omegas, vitamins, and minerals. Per gram, hemp has more digestible protein than soy, more digestible omegas than flax, more digestible fiber than kale, and it's low in saturated fat, cholesterol, and carbs. Consumption of hemp seeds is good for brain function, immune function, weight loss, inflammation, and it reduces the risk of heart disease and cancer.

Biotrust Protein Powder

I love this protein powder because it is hormone-free (no rBGH or rBST), contains no artificial colors, sweeteners, or flavors (it's sweetened with stevia), and it's low carb—only 4 grams of net carbs per serving.

Oceans Alive 2.0

I love Oceans Alive because it is the superfood of the future. It has the power to stimulate your body to create trillions of new cells. Every drop of this microscopic, ultra-powerful ocean nutrient contains more than five billion identical cells of energy that feeds your mitochondria like nothing you have ever experienced.

Quinoa

I love quinoa, because it's another superfood, and a perfect replacement for your rice dishes. Quinoa is gluten-free, it's low in cholesterol and sodium, it's higher in protein than rice, and in one serving, quinoa fills 48% of our magnesium needs.

TIPS & RESOURCES

- Avoid exposure to cancer-causing PFOA from Teflon and other non-stick cookware by phasing them out of your home and purchasing stainless steel or cast iron.
- Choose food labeled “organic,” “pesticide-free,” or “hormone-free” if possible, and shop at your local farmers' market when you can. Many local farmers grow organically, even though they may not be certified.
- Use produce lower in pesticides. Check out the [Environmental Working Group's “Guide to Pesticides in Produce”](#).

Coconut Oil from Tropical Traditions

Organic cold-pressed coconut oil has so many wonderful and healthy uses. Researchers have shown its many health benefits, such as brain boosting, fat burning, and infection fighting, just to name a few. Plus, you can use it for cooking.

Chia Seeds

These tiny seeds are rich in fiber, alpha-linolenic acid, and minerals. In a recent study, researchers found that consuming chia seeds can reduce systolic blood pressure, C-reactive proteins, and vonWillebrand factor—all risk factors for heart disease.

If you're headed to the mall, hit [H&M](#). Now the world's largest purchaser of organic cotton, the brand has made public their goal of phasing out all non-sustainable cotton by 2020, and always carries great organic cotton t-shirts, perfect for stocking stuffing.

Vegan designer [Nicora Johns](#) kickstarted her debut collection last year. Utilizing natural fibers and biodegradable polyurethanes, vegan and non-vegans alike are obsessed with Nicora's modern interpretations of classic styles.

At [Whole Foods Markets](#), check out PACT-certified, organic, low-impact dyed, fair-trade-made leggings—perfect for yoga and life.

At my [Give + Take Swap Boutique](#) in Santa Monica, CA, we discovered [upcycled MixdCo](#) bags. Fold over for an evening bag, or slide your iPad inside; these bags make a perfect gift!

The brainchild of Emily and Betsy Nunez, [Sword & Plough](#) employs veterans to upcycle military gear into accessories, like their Signature Messenger Bag—large enough for an overnight but small enough to take to work—in Coast Guard Blue or Army Green.

The ethnic-jewelry trend isn't going away any time soon. With a certified fair-trade project that microfinances small designers, [Parcel & Journey](#) offers authentically beautiful, handcrafted accessories—such as on-trend stackable bracelets.

Featuring veggie-tanned leather, one of [Calleen Cordero's](#) gorgeous hand-woven multicolor belts might just be the only accessory you need this season.



TIPS & RESOURCES

- **“Organic”** means the garment or accessory is manufactured without pesticides, insecticides, or other synthetic chemicals. Non-organic cotton uses 17% of the world's insecticides. 94% of non-organic cotton is genetically modified. A mere one percent of cotton used in manufacturing is truly organic. Look for these labels: USDA Certified Organic, GOTS (the Global Organic Textile Standard), and Oeko-Tex® Standard 100.
- Many plants can be made into **alternative fabrics**, such as Tencel® (which is derived from eucalyptus trees), linen, bamboo, and hemp. Look for these labels: USDA Certified Organic, GOTS, and Oeko-Tex® Standard 100.
- **“Low-impact dyed”** means the color of the product is achieved using fewer, less environmentally damaging chemicals than some other processes, and less water. Bluesign®-certified products use 45% fewer chemicals and 25% less water.
- **“Fair Trade”** is the business practice of sustainably manufacturing goods in economically disadvantaged areas in order to alleviate poverty and reduce inequality. Look for these labels: Fair Trade Certified, Fair Trade Federation.

Calming Lavender Shampoo & Body Wash is perfect for a calming bath. It's detergent-free, real castile soap that is produced without synthetic fragrances or preservatives. It's also a great hand soap for your entire family.

Silikids Silibib

The non-toxic and recyclable silicone Silibib has a handy pocket for runaway food, is super soft, easy to wipe off, and dishwasher safe.

Under The Nile Scrappy Toys

Scrappies are made from 100% GOTS-certified Egyptian organic cotton scraps left over from Under the Nile's clothing production. What a cute and comforting way to keep scraps out of landfills!

Green Toys Twist Teether

The Twist Teether is made in the USA from 100% food-safe, recycled plastic milk containers without worrisome BPA, PVC, phthalates, or external coatings. It's dishwasher safe, too.



TIPS & RESOURCES

- Look for crib mattresses stuffed with cotton, polyester, or wool, instead of foam. Check out **Getting Ready for Baby** for some safer brands.
- Some car seats can contain brominated flame retardants, PVC, or other heavy metals. Check out the **best and worst brands** of car seats.
- Plastic baby sippy cups, bowls, and utensils can contain BPA or phthalates. Look to **Healthy Child Healthy World** and **The Soft Landing** for safer options.

Katy's Picks

CitiBlocs, or Keva Planks

These are simple wooden planks for creative building of all types; no plastic or commercially themed characters. They foster creativity and spatial reasoning and will biodegrade someday—unlike Legos!

Marble Runs

I recommend buying a marble run made out of wood with tunnels and tracks to avoid the environmental and health problems associated with plastic. Children can learn basic engineering, physics, and spatial skills.

Yoga for Your Brain

Totally Tangled Cards is a card set that features various repeating patterns and designs for drawing. Created to be relaxing and fun, this is a great activity when kids need to relax or take a break from something.

Sleeping Queens

What a simple and fun card game! Created by a 7-year-old girl, this game develops memory and early math skills; a great gift for kids ages 5 and above.

Wreck This Journal

This is a very creative approach to a journal for kids! The author encourages the reader to “wreck” the journal by interacting with it directly while observing the world around them. And by interacting, I mean coloring, ripping, throwing, poking, gluing, scratching—kids will love the permission to destroy and re-create.

Pretend and Play School Set

Many kids love to play pretend school. The Pretend and Play School Set, which comes with a mini-white board, a calendar, markers, and a school-shaped tri-fold, will definitely inspire this

kind of play. You can make your own pretend school kit using any box or bin—just add school supplies, a small white board, a map, calendar, and other items that may inspire your kids!

A Full Dress-Up Bin

For hours and hours of creative play, stock a big trunk or tub with as many dress-up items as you can find from family members, the thrift store, or your own collection: wands, hats, capes, scarves, dresses, uniforms, everything you can think of that will fit. Grandparents often love amassing dress-up clothes for grandkids!

A Bin of Music Instruments

Find some wooden drums, maracas, a xylophone, a ukulele, and other traditional wooden instruments to add to a bin for your child. You can find these instruments at second-hand stores, online, or at a favorite toy store.

Yoga Ball or Large Bouncy Ball

All kids need to bounce! A simple yoga ball can provide a vehicle for movement around the house. During the long winter, indoor movement is essential.

Classic Board Games

Games such as Life, Boggle, Scrabble, Sorry, and Taboo can provide loads of fun for family game nights. Each of these games offers a version for kids, but the adult ones can be modified if they are all you can find.

Bean Bag

- Avoid inexpensive metal jewelry, which is often contaminated with lead or cadmium. Check out **Healthy Stuff** and the **California DTSC** for examples of problem jewelry to avoid.
- Look around local farmers' markets and shops for handmade toys.

Soybu makes stylish, comfortable workout wear designed to empower women. Their products blend eco-friendly fibers into durable fabrics and they make sure they have a minimal impact on the environment.

Orgain

Nutritional Shakes are a delicious, all organic option for complete nutrition and supportive protein. They come in vegan, nutritional protein and original nutritional shake, as well as a Healthy Kids Nutritional Shake formula in a variety of yummy flavors. They also sell plant Protein Powder.

GoodOnYaBar is certified organic, gluten-free, non-GMO, and made with real food to nourish you, such as sprouted flax, hemp seeds, and chia. These bars contain 6-10 grams of protein, and 9-10 grams of sugar, sweetened by raw honey or maple syrup.

No gym bag is complete without a high quality deodorant, but most major brands contain lots of toxins. **Primal Pit Paste** is the exception. TIPS & RESOURCES

- Look for fitness apparel from companies that offer certified organic cotton or Merino wool fabrics—or for products that have been certified by bluesign®, which tests products for their safety for consumers and the planet.
- Avoid fitness gear (hand weights, yoga mats, etc) made with materials such as petroleum-based plastics, PVC, or phthalates.
- Opt for BPA-free, reusable, stainless-steel water bottles for your workout.


TIPS & RESOURCES






